The DBA emphasizes that our athletes be positive examples to all players, coaches, and parents, statewide. We will show respect to everyone on and off the court. It is the duty of the player to adhere to these values. I understand that my actions on and off the court affect not only my personal well-being, but can also interfere with the level of unity required to keep my team and myself successful. I acknowledge that my conduct can be evaluated at any time by my coaches and DBA Officials. Failure to comply may result in immediate dismissal from the team and other DBA programs.
